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# 1 Tonemacro use and format

**Legacy Version** - This page is about a legacy version of AllStarLink. See <sup>1</sup>

A 'tonemacro' is much like a normal macro (see also Macro use and format <sup>2</sup>)

Mutiple tones can each have their own macro execution. And each node may have it's own set. It activates the programmed macro/string based on a PL Tone received. Or NOT.

Note required that you are using dsp functions of USBRadio and proper tone config in the usbradio.conf required.

rxctcssfreqs=100.0,203.5 -USBRadio.conf <sup>3</sup>

```
[tonemacro29284]
```

```
100.0=*671
```

```
203.5=*711
```

```
[tonemacro29285]
```

```
100.0=*672 *8910
```

```
203.5=*712
```

Use your imagination as this can be used very powerfully. But be careful in thinking out the full implications of what you are doing.
